As an Operational Risk Officer, you will contribute to the identification, management and reporting of the Bank's operational risk. You will participate to the reporting of the operational risk indicators and operational risk events to the Management.

You will report to the Head of the Operational Risk department and work in close collaboration with the other colleagues of the Risk department and with other relevant services of the Bank.

Key responsibilities

- Contribute to the maintenance and the continuous development of the operational risk management framework, including the review and improvement of the operational risk management policy, measurement methodologies, procedures, quidelines and directives, based on best practice, internal audits points and the needs of the business of the Bank;
- As second line of defense, independently monitor, evaluate and challenge the operational risks management performed by the business units (the first lines of defense);
- Contribute to the continuous strengthening of the control framework of the Operational Risk department in particular with the development of end-user-computing solutions with VBA and SQL;
- Perform operational risk controls in accordance with the Bank's Risk Control Plan and more particularly implement and execute the operational risk control plan;
- Coordinate the collection of the operational risk indicators;
- Manage and monitor the operational incidents, challenge the status- and ensure that appropriate follow-up actions are implemented, facilitating the optimization/improvement of business units processes;
- Prepare the operational risk reports to the management and the Risk Committee of the Bank;
- · Advise business units on complex operational risk issues, and provide expert input and data when required;
- Contribute to the calculation of capital adequacy requirements and stress test data for operational risk and to the maintenance and development of the related methodology;

- Contribute to the operational risk assessment of transversal projects, new products and services and represent the
 Operational Risk Unit on matters related to operational risk identification, assessment, monitoring and/or reporting
 activities as required;
- Promote a culture of operational risk awareness by delivering ongoing operational risk training to staff at all levels and by contributing to the delivery of specific operational risk training sessions.

- Master degree, preferably in Economics, Banking, Finance, Information Technology, Mathematics and/or Statistics or a relevant field;
- Minimum 2 years' experience in operational risk management or in another control;
- Good understanding of operational risk regulations and best practices such as Basel II/III
- Good command of programming languages, software applications and databases used in operational risk services in banks (e.g. VBA, SQL, Excel);
