

REQUEST FOR SUSPENSION OF PAYMENTS SUBMITTED BY THE CSSF FOR
BANQUE HAVILLAND S.A.

Banque Havilland S.A. informs the public that it has been notified a request for suspension of payments submitted by the CSSF to the District Court of Luxembourg, in accordance with article 122 of the law of 18 December 2015 on the failure of credit institutions and certain investment firms submitted on 1 August 2024.

This request follows a decision of 1 August 2024, effective as of 2 August 2024, from the European Central Bank to withdraw the licence of Banque Havilland S.A. as a credit institution within the meaning of article 1 of the law of 5 April 1993 on the financial sector, as amended.

Until further decision from the District Court of Luxembourg, the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier (CSSF) act as administrator in order to control the management of the bank's assets.

This protection regime implies a suspension of all payments by the bank and the prohibition of all acts other than precautionary and protective measures, subject to prior authorisation by the administrator.
